This administrative guideline is applicable to all materials (apart from books), furniture and equipment purchased with Board funding, school generated funds or acquired through donations or donated funds. The Purchasing Department will be responsible for the relocation and/or disposal of all Board identified surplus materials, equipment and furniture.

It is important to note that all contents and fi tures of a Board owned facilit are the propert of the Near North District School board and therefore individual emplo ees, schools or departments do not have the unilateral authorit to dispose of an such item(s). Absolutel no items are to be removed or sold without the pre-approval of either the
